When there are more than one piece of furniture at, or very close to each other at a parish boundary, then from the location data alone it may be difficult to assign the photo to one or other of those items without looking at the photo and making a judgement ! An example from above is 110_46 and 209_83 (a bridge and a stile).

After finding the parish number or abbreviation and furniture number for a photo the file can be renamed to include that information.
