Filenames of photos of PRow Furniture (stiles, gates) etc.

Photo files may be named like "oppp_fff_yyyyMMdd_hhmmss.jpg" where "ppp" is a Parish number and "fff" is a Furniture (e.g. bridge, finger_post, gate, stile etc.) number. The start format "oppp" applies to Oxfordshire. For Buckinghamshire filenames may start with an abbreviation-based code for the parish. The photo may show more than one piece of "furniture". If looking down the list of photos for a particular item of furniture then it may be necessary to look for files with numbers in the "furniture" part matching nearby "furniture". Many bridges have associated stiles and a photo showing both these items may be named based on one of those "furniture" items.

For Oxfordshire there may be a notes file in my website (near this note) showing a URL for the full list of parish numbers and some example numbers for parishes I have taken photos in.

For Buckinghamshire I can't quickly find a list of official abbreviations for parishes. Here are some examples :-
